2,488 unique individuals served

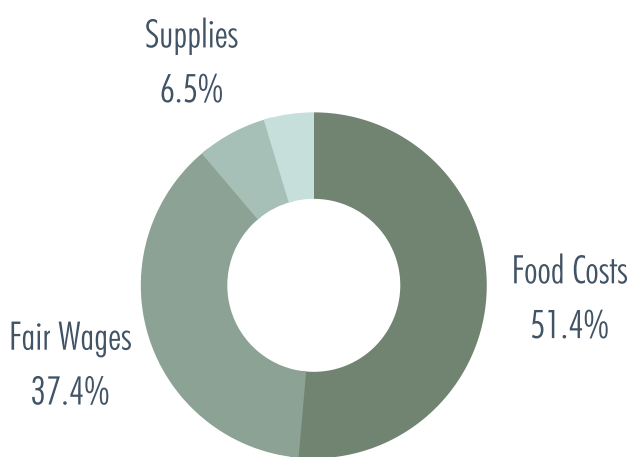


- Transformed an abandoned, empty lot into a full scale distribution and community center

- Ran a weekly, local farm stand
- Worked with 12 schools and 2 local charter schools to bring fresh groceries to families in the 2020-2021 school year
- Continued consistent & free grocery delivery to 622 households across Queens

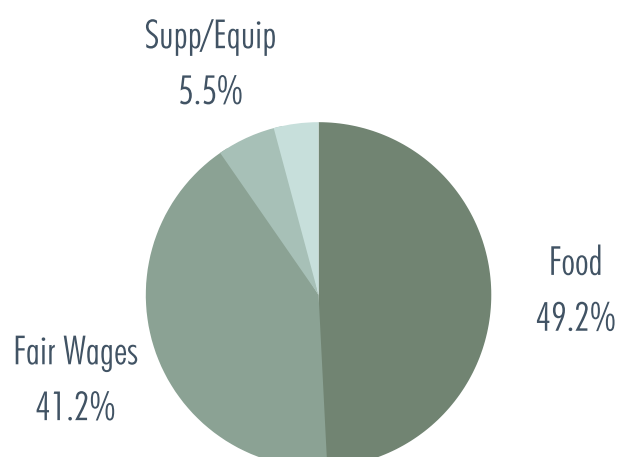
- Deepened our communications to provide additional support and resources to current community members

- Collaborated with mutual aid and community partners to pressure local elected officials on current unjust systems of food
- Realigned our community partnerships to deepen our commitment to dismantling the charity model of food distribution prevalent in NYC relief programs
- Built internal practices that allow our team to thrive and maintain work-life balance.
- Built internal structures of accountability and decision making to ensure all major decisions are made unilaterally
- Invested 200 hours in mentoring 8 youth through the SYEP Summer work program.
